Our ninth league season will commence in June 2008 and tenth in November 2008, and will operate provisionally Monday to Thursday from 6.45pm to 10pm and Saturday – Sunday 9am to 4pm. All leagues are affiliated to the Essex County Football Association, consisting usually of 9 teams (may change), with a full promotion and relegation system in place, and superb prizes for the winners. Teams play once a week, with each match lasting 40 minutes. Each league season will last for 16 weeks (may change depending on league sizes), and will run continually all year round. League places are limited so please do not delay in registering your team, application forms can be found at the back of the pack, or alternatively please feel free to contact a member of our team.

Our pitches are available seven days a week, from 4.45pm to 10pm Monday to Thursday, 4.45pm to 9pm on Fridays and 9am to 4pm Saturday and Sunday. Five-a-side Leagues – Overview

All pitches are set to the necessary requirements of five-a-side football as set out by the FA and the playing rules of futuresoccer comply with those of the FA for 'small-sided football', including disciplinary matters.

All leagues are affiliated to the Essex County Football Association and as such all of our referees are appropriately qualified.

Each league will consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of twelve teams, with each team playing all the other teams in the league once, with a full promotion and relegation system in place.

Every match is 40 minutes in duration, and league games will be played on the same day each week, however the kick-off times may vary – each team will be given a full fixture list prior to the start of each season. A new season will begin (in most instances) the week after the last game of the previous season.

A maximum of 15 players may be registered per team at the start of each season, however only 8 of these can be named in a match day squad.

All players must wear shinpads in order to play, and no studded, moulded or bladed football boots are allowed.

The registration fee and deposit must be paid prior to the start of a new season, failure to do so may result in a team being removed from a league.

The registration fee is a seasonal cost to ensure each team is entered into a league and affiliated to the Essex County FA.

The deposit is taken to ensure teams turn up for their fixtures, acting as one weeks leagues fees taken in advance – it virtually ensures teams have a fixture to play every week and reduces friendlies. The deposit is fully refundable at the end of each season, providing a team has fulfilled all of its fixtures. A postponement procedure is in place, whereby each team is allowed to postpone one match per season, and not lose their deposit. However this must be done with a minimum of 7 days notice, and replayed within 14 days.

If a team does not turn up for a fixture and has not followed the postponement procedure, they will lose their deposit. If this is not repaid within 48 hours of the fixture the team may lose their place in the leagues and be replaced by another team.

Full details of the league rules and regulations are available direct from futuresoccer, and will be issued to each team at registration.
